IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING RESPECT IN SPORT FOR 2021 – 2022 SEASON

It is **MANDATORY** that all parents/guardians of players be certified in Respect in Sport – Parent (RIS) prior to players being allowed to participate in on-ice activity with Stettler Minor Hockey.

The Respect in Sport Parents course takes approximately 1 - 1.5 hours to complete, and is offered through the Respect Group website.

We are asking that all parents/guardians with an **existing RIS certificate** login to the Respect Group website to ensure that their certificate is valid. Courses completed from 2018 onwards are considered valid – if your certificate is from 2017, please check with the Martyne at registrar@stettlerminorhockey.com. Courses completed prior to 2016 are no longer valid.


The process of adding a **new player to an existing RIS certificate** is also outlined below for parents with a new player in hockey this season who may have an older sibling for which a certificate exists.




From a desktop computer, a quick check to the upper right corner shows certificate number and expiration date




If you are non-compliant, you will be directed to re-certify in the Respect in Sport for Parents course





Adding a New Player to an Existing RIS Certificate:

From a desktop computer, please login as instructed above and check to see if certificate is valid in upper right corner, and continuing to PROFILE page




From the Profile page, click on the Child Management tab and then on Add Child






Input player information, ensuring that STETTLER is added as the minor hockey association











Parents will enter Account Information, and scroll a little further down the page to the Child Management section and ADD CHILD
