Dear Jerilyne,

This letter is to inform Stettler Minor Hockey Association (SMHA) that Alberta Health Services (AHS) has advised the Stettler Recreation Centre (SRC) that they have received multiple complaints relative to public health measures not being followed by spectators of SMHA teams.

As you are aware, masks must be worn at all times when inside the building, except for youth while engaged in physical activity. Spectator attendance is restricted to 350 spectators in the blue arena and 60 spectators in the red arena, attendees are limited to a single household or 2 close contacts if living alone and maintain 2 metres physical distancing.

Please be advised that future ice sessions will be cancelled for these teams and potentially other SMHA teams should further complaints be received.

Lastly, we have recently been advised that AHS are sending 'test shoppers' around to ensure facilities such as the SRC are in compliance with current public health measures.

I trust that you will advise your \_\_\_\_\_ teams of the complaints received and additionally remind all teams of the current public health measures in place when inside the SRC.
