## STETTLER RECREATION CENTRE ARENA USER RULES AND GUIDELINES

*Updated February 9, 2022*

The Arena User Rules and Guidelines have been established to align with current Government of Alberta Health and Safety Measures that have been implemented province-wide in an effort to reduce the impact of the pandemic.

- All Alberta Health Services (AHS) health and safety recommendations must be followed.
- All facility patrons must wear a mask while in the building (except youth while participating in activity).
- All facility patrons should practice proper hand hygiene while in the facility, including before and after on ice activities.
- All facility patrons must screen for symptoms prior to entering the building. If a patron does not feel well, has a fever, upset stomach, headache or a cold (runny nose, sore throat, cough, etc.) they must stay home.
- Upon entering there will be a hand sanitizer station set up for all on-ice participants and spectators to use. Hand sanitizer stations are also available throughout the building. Masks are also available at the front entry for any patrons requiring one.
- Spectator attendance is restricted in the Blue Arena only to a maximum of 500 spectators.
